RIGHT OF ADDMISSION RESERVED

Fees:

Vehicles on show: No charge for the vehicle itself before 08h30

First Two Occupants Free, Rest in car at R100 per person,

Children under 12 enter for free

Cars allowed on Track - Pre 1985 for as well as vehicles from

members of participating clubs

Unimogs and Super cars on exhibit exempt as special vehicles

Gates Open 05h15 for vendors

06h00 till 09h30 for vehicle exhibitors

08h00 for spectators

Departure Vendors must stay till 17h00

Vehicle Exhibitors must stay till 15h00 onwards in order to ensure

sound and safe traffic control

Pedestrian spectators: R100 per person,

Children under 12 enter for free

POMC members not exhibiting or not working – full charge

Other club's members not exhibiting – full charge

Exhibitors 2 persons per vehicle for free

additional passengers older than 12 years R100,- per person.

Special Invites: Free of charge with proof of invite

Must report at ticket office just inside the main gate with documentation to proof stand allocation and payment. Pre-paid entry – must provide proof payment at entry

Proof of Membership Entering with a post 1985 vehicle will require valid in-date proof of

Club membership.

Entry WILL BE refused if membership can not be shown.

Trailers and Club Support Vehicles

Trailers: All trailers must be parked in the trailer park outside of Gate 2

North of ZOC Clubhouse NO EXCEPTION ALLOWED

Support Vehicles: Permission must be obtained from the organiser one week before Cars

in the Park (by Friday 28 July 2018).

Such vehicles, without permission, will be refused entry to the Track Support vehicles must be parked in the Trailer Park after off-loading.

NO EXCEPTION ALLOWED

Entry Gates:

Gate 1: At the Mercedes Clubhouse

Vehicle exhibitors only

NO VENDORS

Recommended for stands numbers 1 to 60

Gate 2: At top "Main Gate" Next to Skid pan

Exhibitors and Pedestrians

Vendors enter only at this gate before 6h00 Recommended for stands numbers 1 to 60

Gate 4: At bottom next to main road

Vehicle exhibitors only

NO VENDORS

Recommended for stands 61 to 117

Exhibitors (Club Members and Non-Club Members):

Clubs: Per demarcated area

As per map – Use the gate closest to the demarcated club stand

Non-clubs: Past the pits – round the hairpin

Northern "straight" parking area to the left and right

Access and Exit Roads:

Main entry: One-way until 12h00 up to Mercedes Club House

Exhibitors for Gate 1 and Gate 2 must keep right – rest keep left for

parking.

POMC members exhibiting enter at Gate 2

Ring Road: Past Gate 2, right around skid pan, keep right past 4x4 tracks, past

quad bikes, past new go-kart track, past Gate 5, out to main road.

Left, turn only onto main road.

General Rules for the Day

• Driving around the track will be strictly regulated AS A SAFETY PRECAUTION for pedestrians, take shortest route to stand and park

- Being or driving under the influence or reckless driving will be directed to the SAPS to deal with
- Speeding will not be tolerated and any person found to be speeding will be escorted from the track, regardless
- No open fires will be allowed, only gas braai or enclosed fires is allowed. Visible fire extinguishing equipment will be required at all times
- Zwartkops has a liquor license so please do not bring your own liquor
- Starting and revving of engines is not allowed without written permission.
- No "FOR SALE" or "TO RENT" signs are allowed on track without permission, an area will be allocated opposite the go kart track for vehicles for sale (Stand number 124). Contact organiser to arrange parking. Driver and passengers of for sale vehicles will have to pay entrance fee.
- Vehicle Exhibitors are not allowed to sell or swap any items without permission obtained from the organisers before 1st July 2019.
